Each paper must use 12 point Times New Roman font with double space. Cited sources at the end are required(including cases,statutes, law review articles, etc).

Topic Selection

The topic shall be selected by students .The students shall prepare the topic and writing outlines for the final paper.

Monitoring contemporary events and class participation

Class participation will account for 60 percent of the grade in the class.

Students are encouraged to track and report on Asia climate change news updates. A vibrant dialogue is desired for the course to maximize student engagement and understanding.
